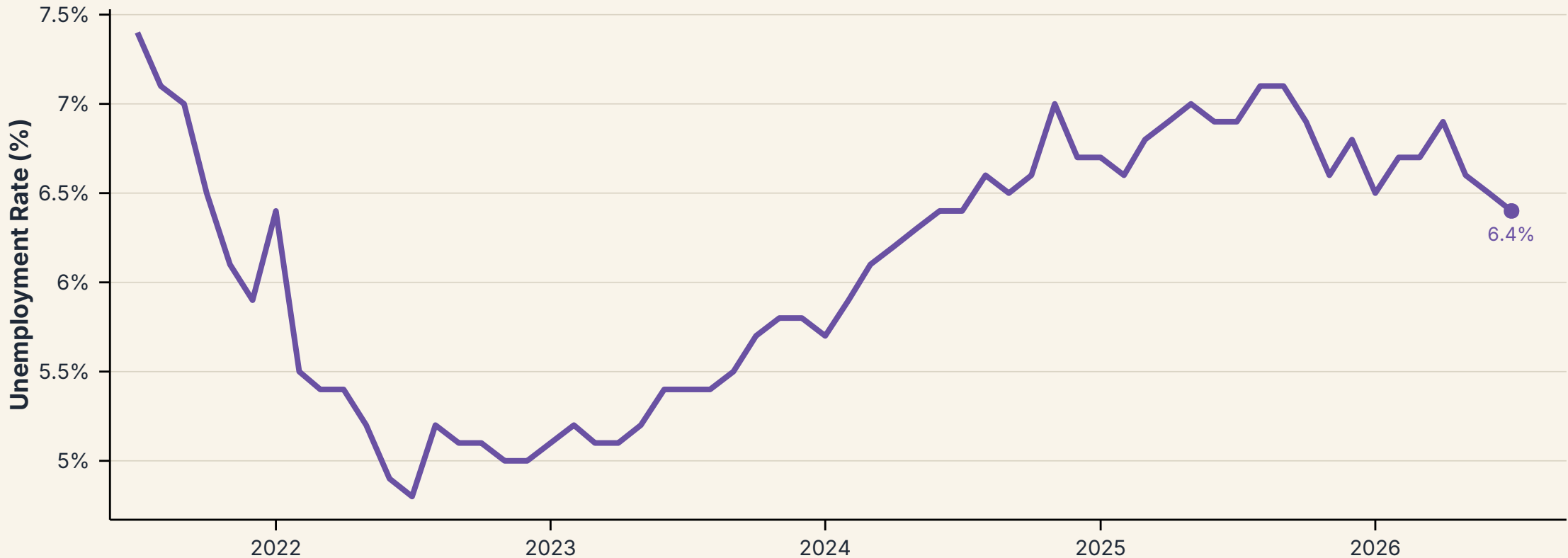


Canada's Unemployment Rate

Persons 15 and over, seasonally adjusted · July 2026: 6.4% · range over the five years shown, 4.8% to 7.4%



Notes: The unemployed are people without work who looked for work in the past four weeks or were on temporary layoff, as a share of everyone working or looking. Someone who gives up looking leaves the rate entirely, which can pull it down in a weak market.
