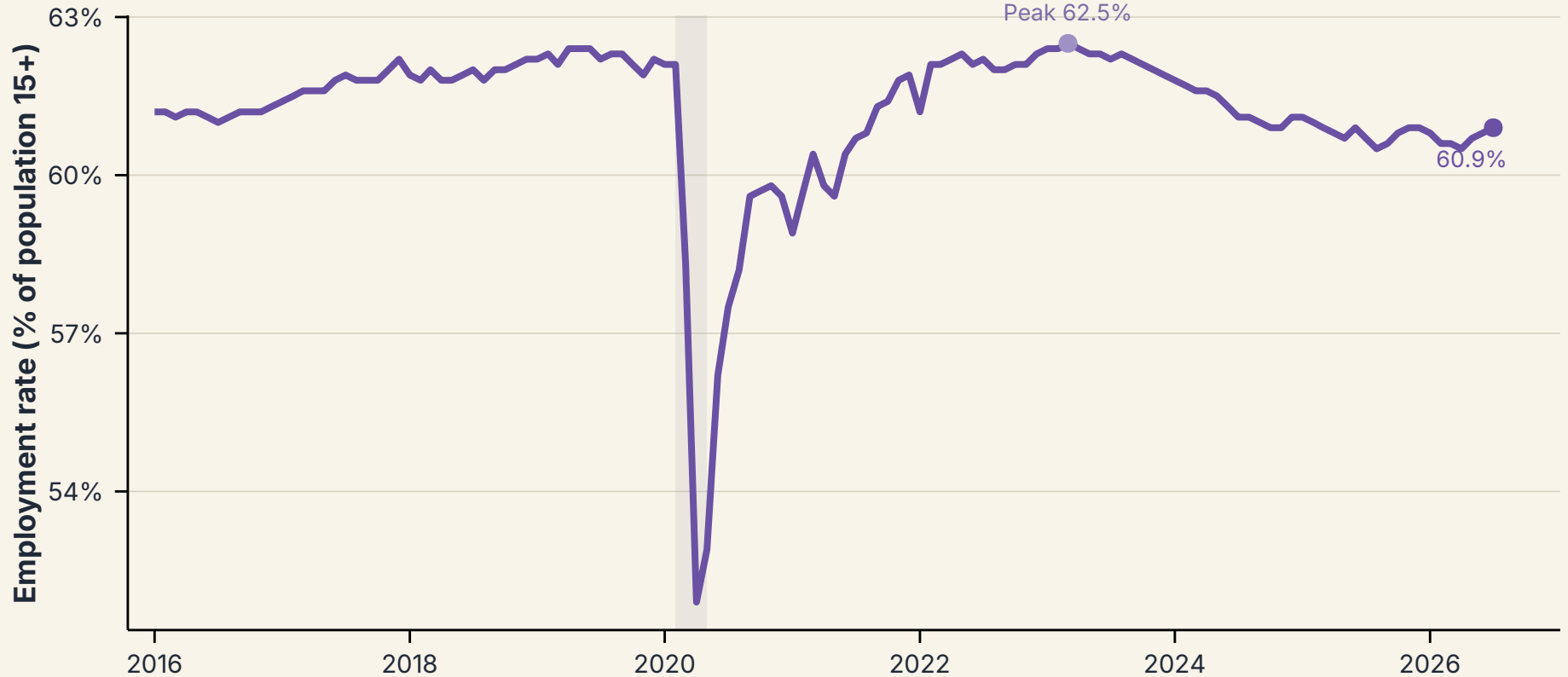


What Share of Canadians Have a Job?

Employment rate, 15 and over, seasonally adjusted · July 2026: 60.9%



Notes: Everyone aged 15 and over is in the denominator, students and retirees included, which is why this rate sits near 60% and is not comparable with a prime-age (25-54) employment rate. A falling rate means employment is not keeping pace with population growth. Shaded: recessions (C.D. Howe Business Cycle Council).
