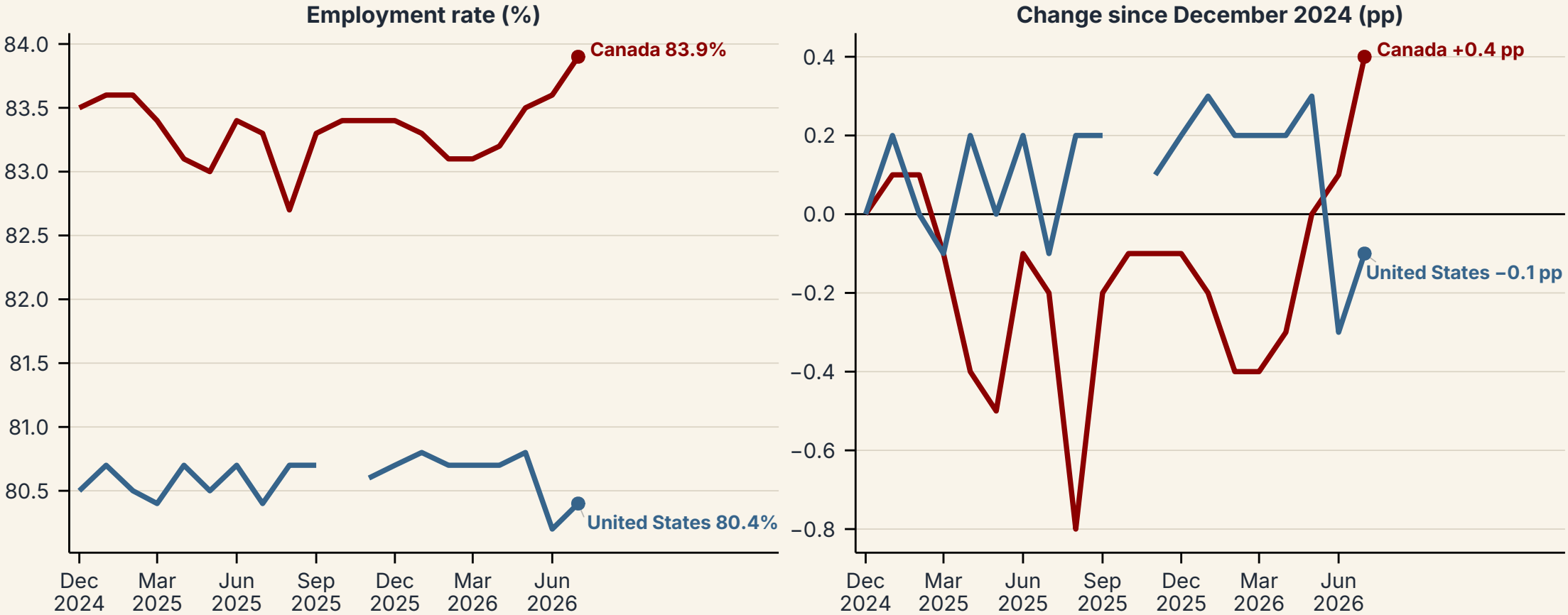


Canada Has the Higher Prime-Age Employment Rate, by 3.5 Percentage Points
