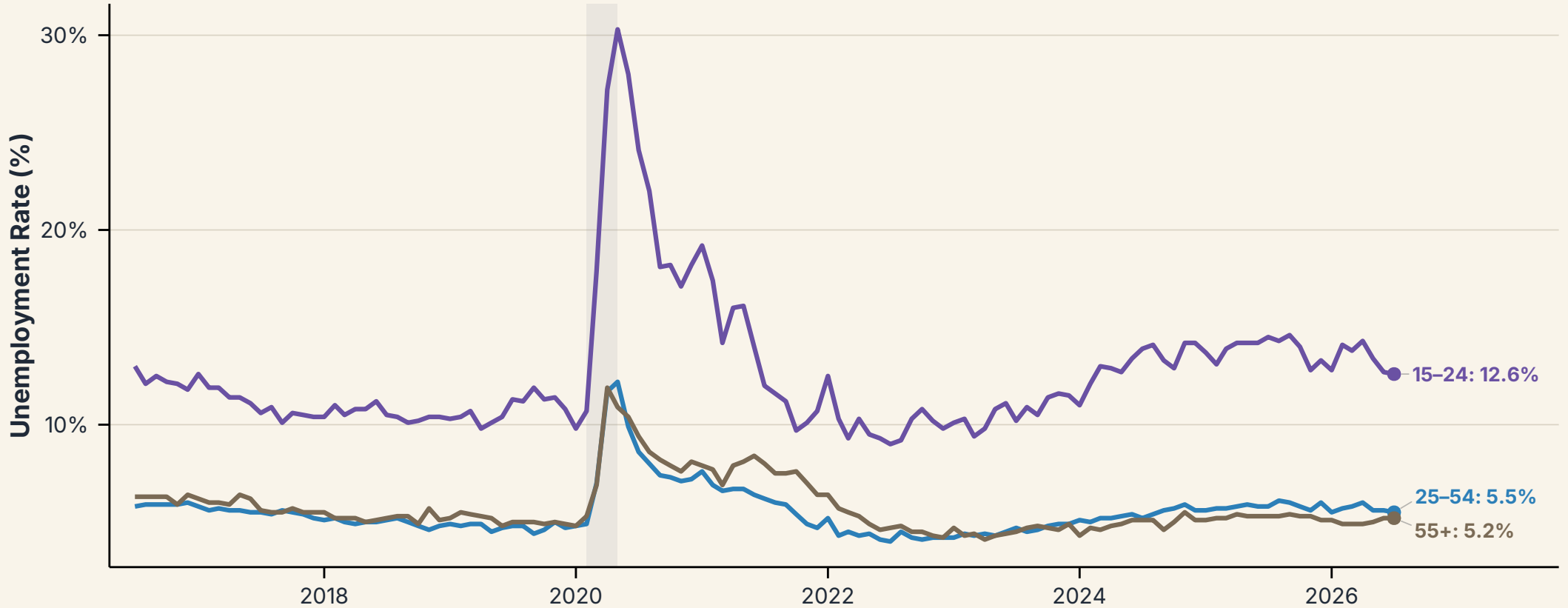


Youth Unemployment Is 2.3 Times the Rate for Canadians 25 to 54

Notes: Unemployment rate by age group, seasonally adjusted. The 15-24 group is mostly students and recent entrants, who move between jobs and in and out of the labour force far more often than older workers, so its rate is structurally the highest of the three and is read by its movement rather than its level. Shaded: recessions (C.D. Howe Business Cycle Council).
