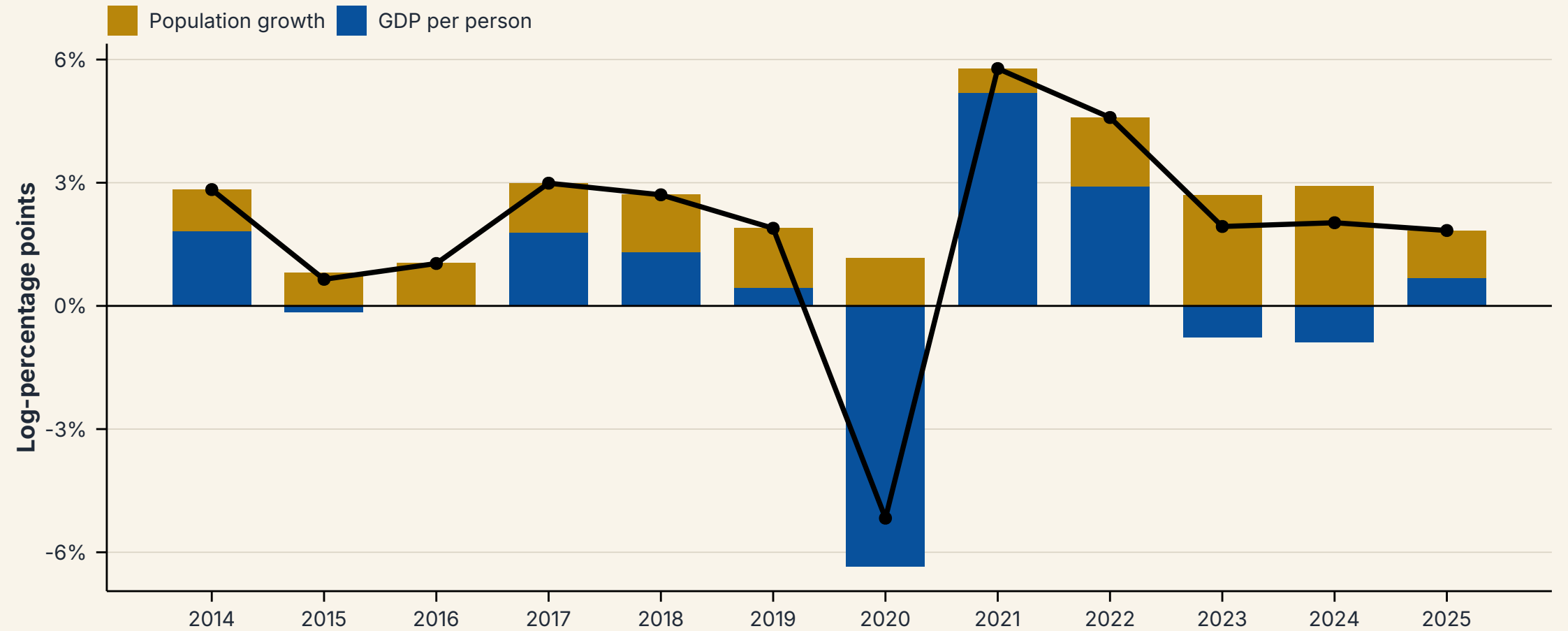


Canada Grew by Adding People, Not Prosperity (2025)
