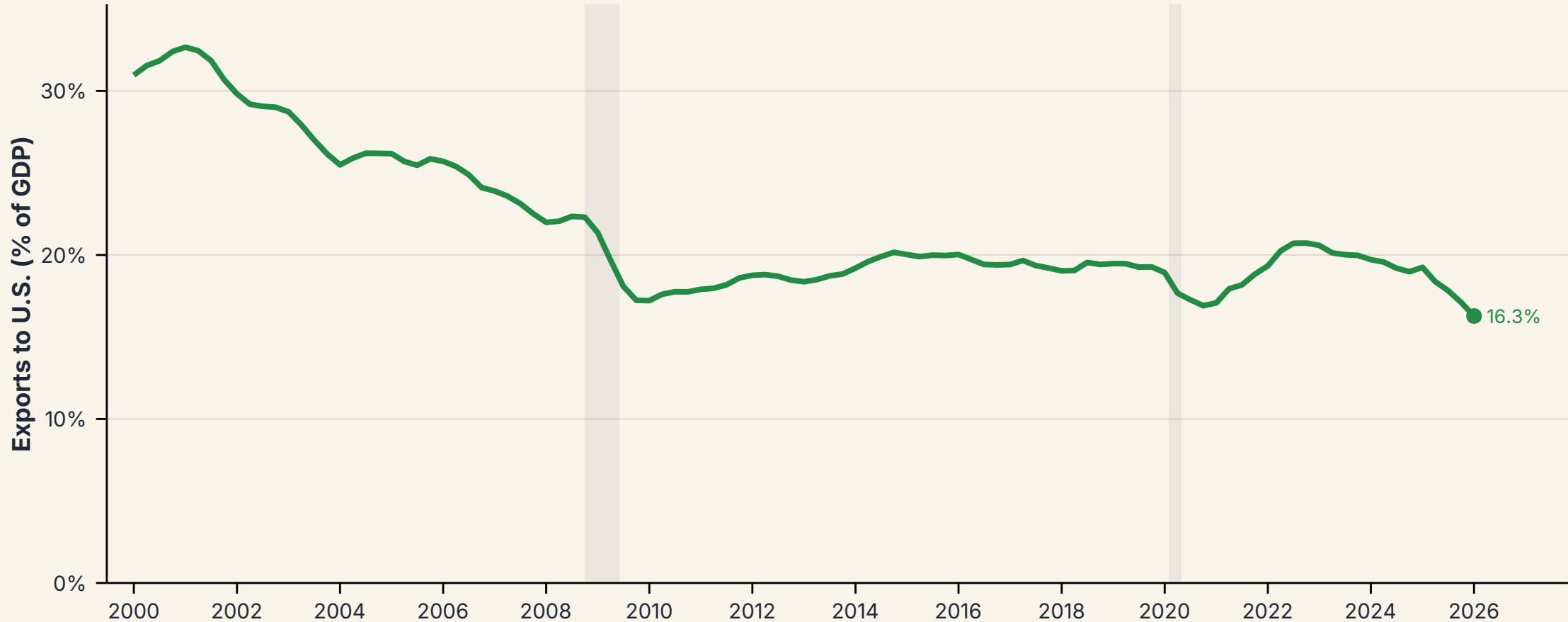


How Much of Canada's Economy Rides on U.S. Exports
