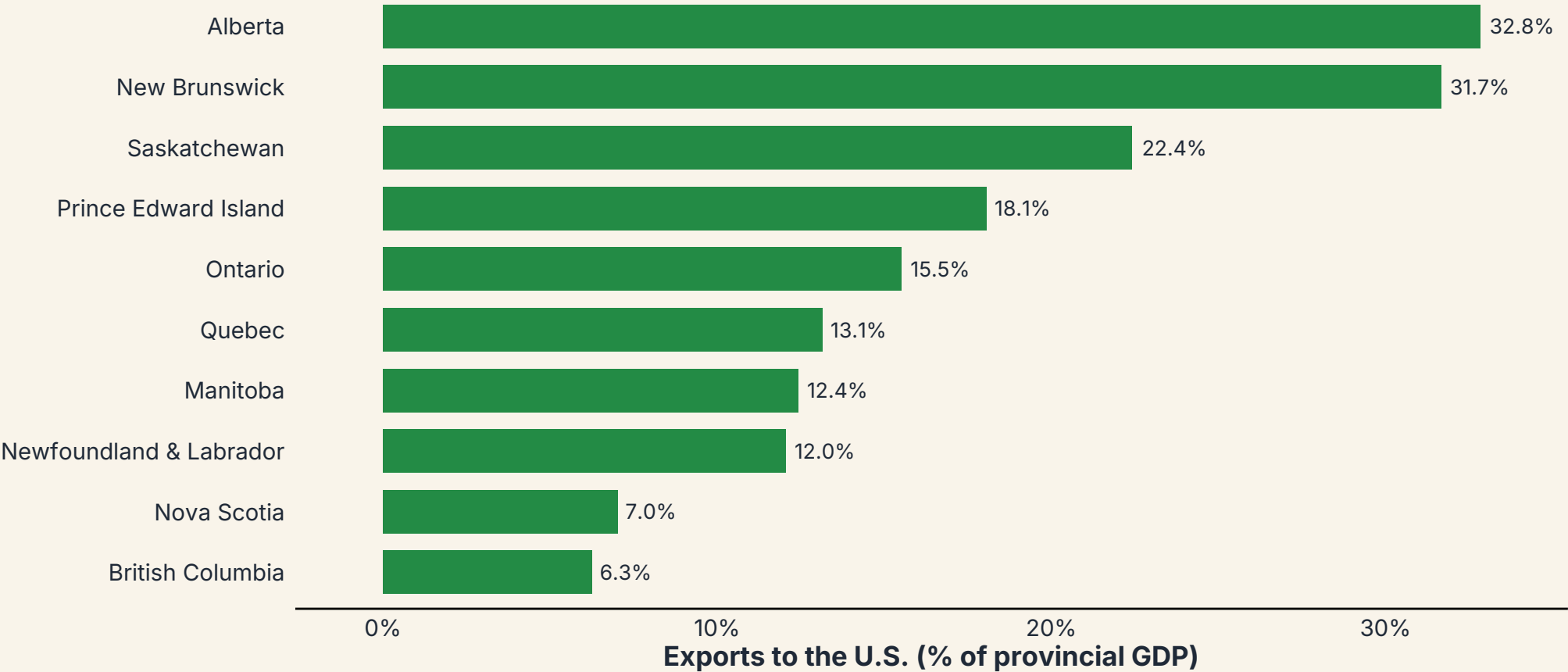


Tariff Exposure: U.S. Exports vs. Provincial GDP

Notes: Domestic merchandise exports to the United States (customs basis, not seasonally adjusted, trailing-12-month sum) as a share of provincial nominal GDP. Re-exports are attributed nationally, not provincially; services exports excluded. Not all of these exports face a duty, and gross exports are set against value-added GDP, so each bar is an upper bound on exposure.
